Ordering AutoCAD

Update your Personal Information

In advance of registering for the software

- Add your birth date to the your OpenEd student record. Log in to the <u>OpenEd</u> student portal and select "My Profile". You will be asked for your birth date when you register for AutoCAD.
- Your name in your student record must match the name you will provide with your AutoCAD registration. If you used a nickname or short form on your student record, e.g., Pat instead of Patricia, make sure you enter the same name when creating your AutoCAD account.
- In your student record, select "My Enrolment History". Under "Actions and Status", select a Confirmation of Attendance. You will need this document to complete your AutoCAD registration.

Registering for the AutoCAD Software

Registering for the AutoCAD software requires several steps and approvals. It may take several days before your software access begins.

- Visit <u>Autodesk Educational Access</u>. You can view the "How it works video" or "Get Started" to create an account.
- Create your account. Your institution is University of Guelph, Guelph. Your department is OpenEd.
- Once your account is created, you can select to visit the Canadian website.
- Complete your application by uploading the Confirmation of Attendance letter.
- Once your application is approved, follow the instructions to access the AutoCAD software.
